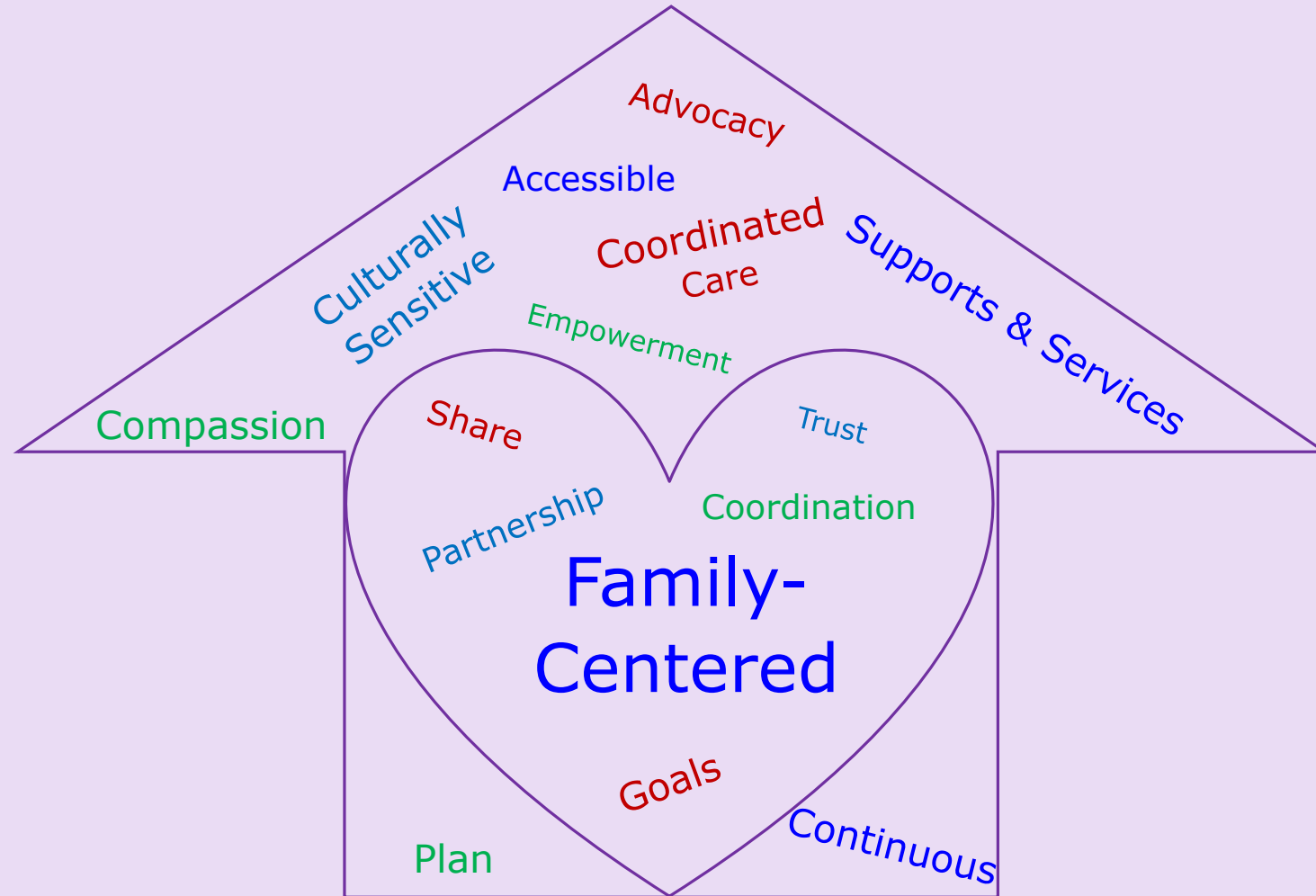

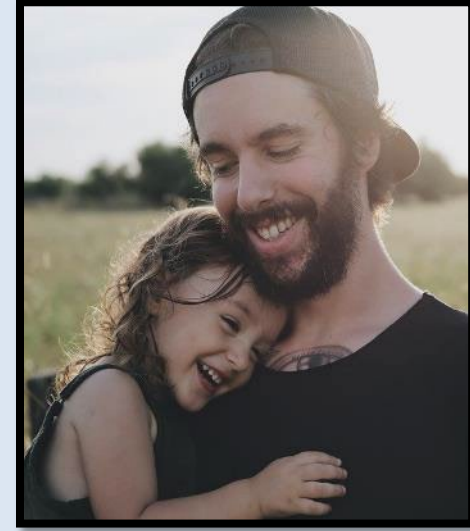

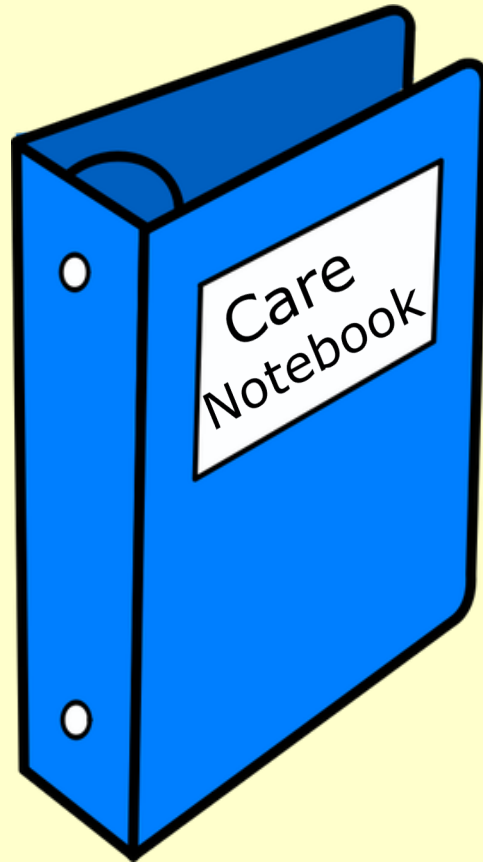

Assembling a Care Notebook



Care Notebooks

- Help you organize all your child's information
- Create an opportunity to share strengths of your child
- Share it with providers, schools, and caregivers
- Give you confidence to partner with your child's providers
- Have forms that can help you track expenses for reimbursement

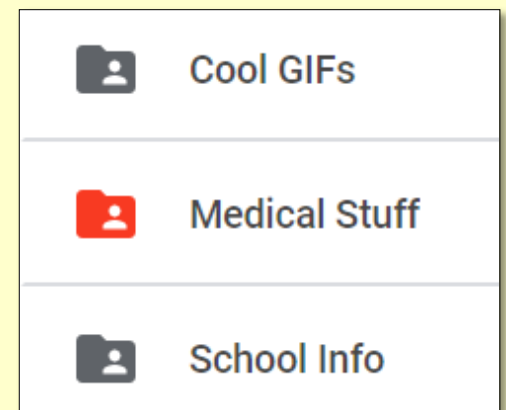
Care Notebooks can be different for each family

Requesting a Shared Plan of Care

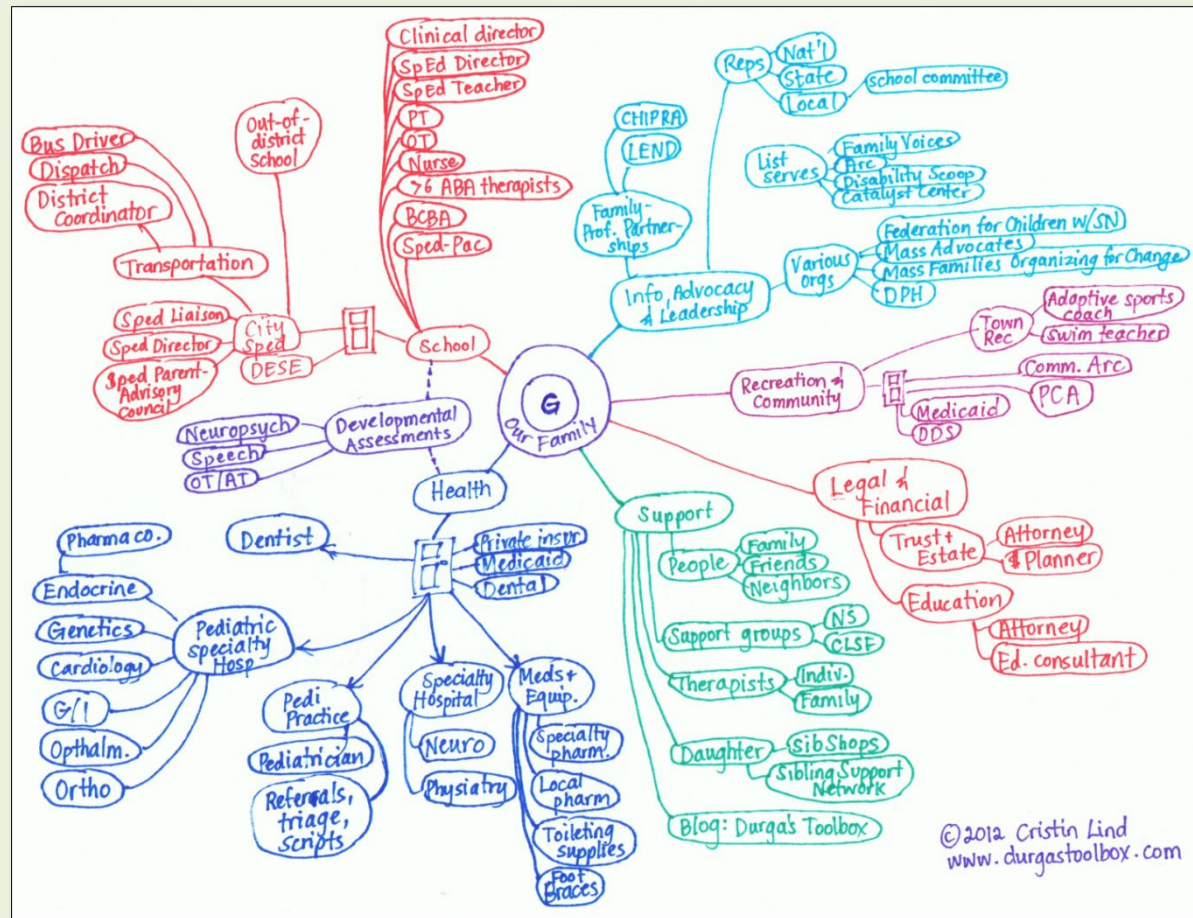


What is a Shared Plan of Care (SPoC)?

A shared plan of care is a *tool for communication*. It contains information about your child:

- Your child's medical summary
- Information about your family and other important people in your child's life
- Goals and plans to achieve them
- What to do in an emergency (action or emergency plan)
- You can share it!

Exploring Care Mapping



Care Mapping

A visual way to show all the people and services involved in caring for and supporting your child
