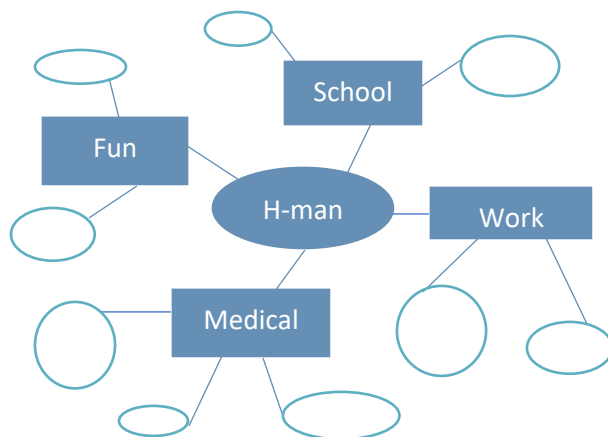


# Exploring Care Mapping
